Last year, \$3.8 trillion of global e-commerce spend was influenced by **unverified** online reviews ¹

In some sectors, up to 2/3rds of these reviews were fake ²

This cost consumers \$152 billion ¹

The Problem: Effect on Consumers

Review fakery is endemic, sophisticated and widespread ^{1, 2, 3}

Awareness of the problem is increasing

There are **no standards** and **no global trustmark**

Consumers have no way to know **which reviews are fake**

The Problem: Impact on Businesses

Faking reviews has become a commercial imperative

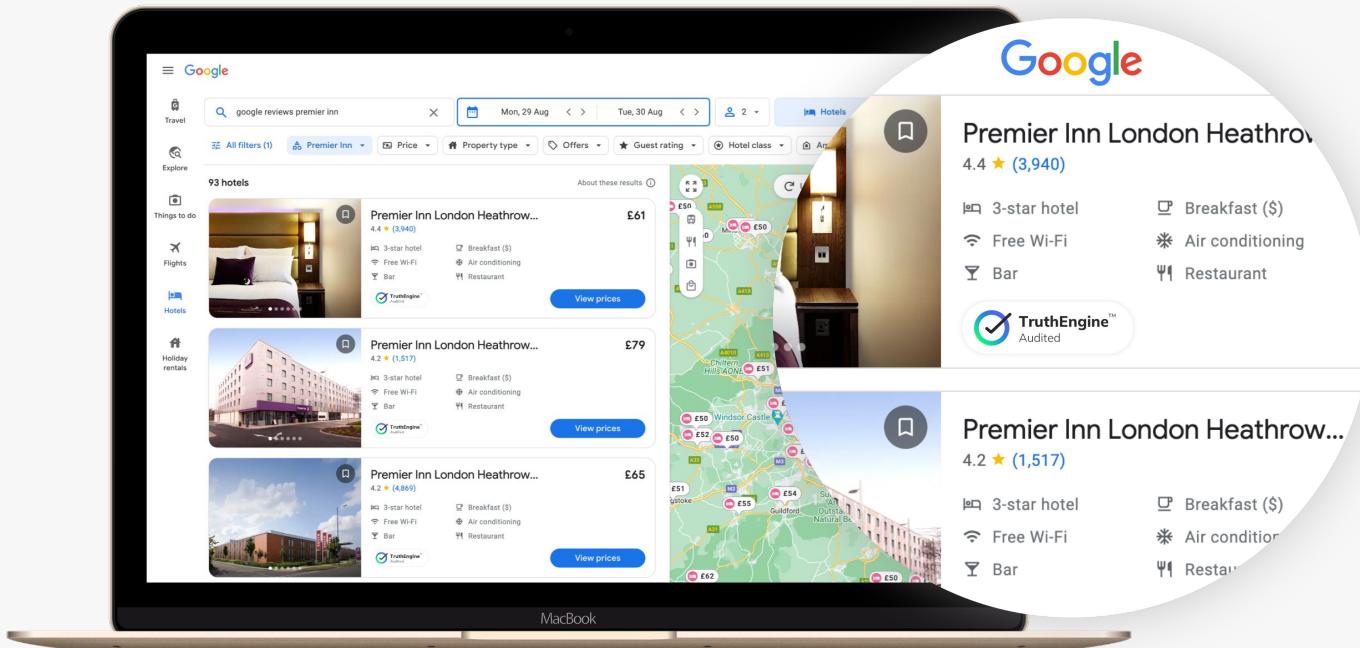

Review Fakery (n.) Any action taken by a business to artificially increase the rating of their business or negatively affect the rating of a competitor.

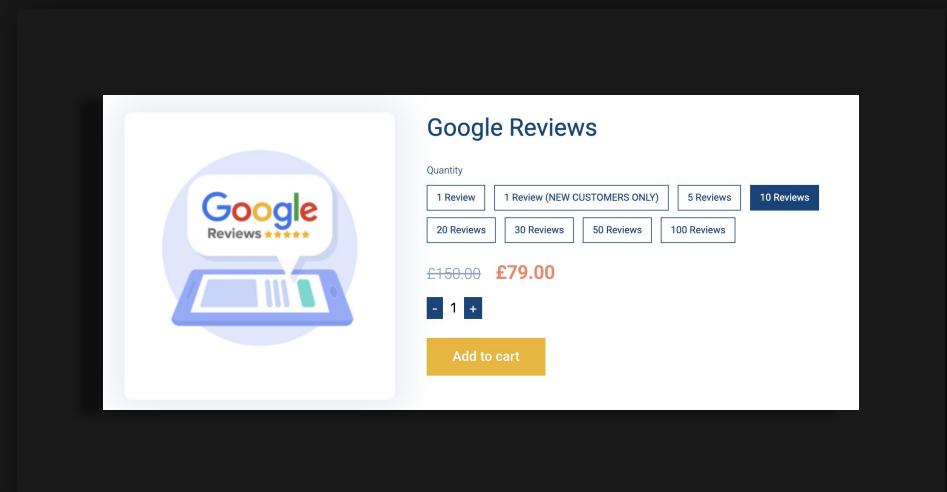
Types of Review Fakery

The five classes of review fakery:

- Direct manipulation
- Incentivised reviews
- Switched reviews
- Review 'gating'
- Review 'flagging'

Direct Manipulation

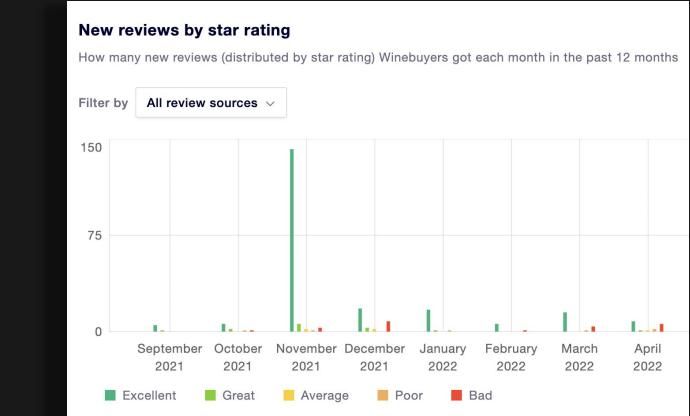
Bulk purchase of reviews through fake review brokers or by instructing friends, family or staff to post fake reviews directly.



You can bulk purchase online reviews, like this package from “Gold Star Marketing”

Incentivised Reviews

Businesses asking customers to leave a positive review in return for a discount or an upgrade or employees being strongly incentivised to push customers for reviews in return for cash bonuses or perks.



A massive spike of positive reviews

In November, if you left a positive review you got a free crate of wine.

Switched Reviews

Changing the listing of a product or service whilst keeping its previous reviews

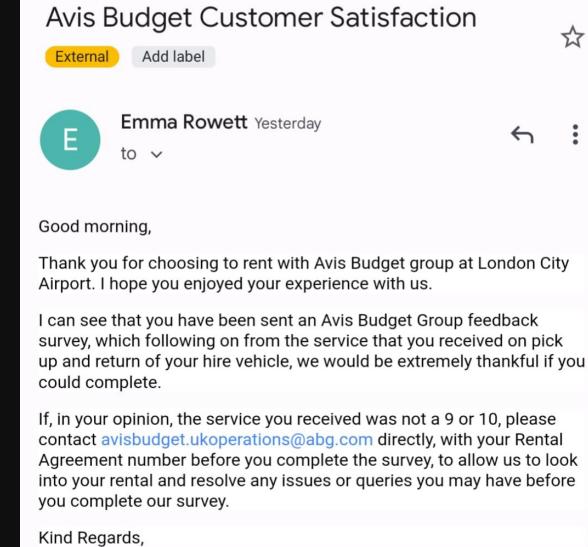

Review ‘Gating’

Businesses asking for reviews from customers they know to be satisfied.

This introduces sampling bias to their review data, improving their score.



Review ‘Flagging’

Several leading review platforms allow businesses to ‘flag’ specific reviews.

Businesses exploit this loophole to have some or all of their negative reviews removed.

Only the positive reviews remain which inflates the score and customers get misled.

Winebuyers's flagging activity

How frequently Winebuyers flagged their reviews in the past 12 months

- Winebuyers flagged 75 of their reviews a total of 76 times. ⓘ
- 4% of those cases turned out to be invalid.
